Fluorescent Lamp Recycling Containers

Universal waste regulations require generators to properly manage mercury containing materials through recycling. Proper recycling of mercury containing materials can reduce your environmental liability and ensures the long-term preservation of the environment.

Regulatory protocol under Universal Waste Ruling provides an exemption for DOT/UN Certification status. Exemption is based on upon the volume of mercury content in mercury containing fluorescent lamps (~30 mg./bulb). Under 450 grams per container, container is exempt, no certification required.
